

**WUBE / Premier Shooting & Training Center "Florida Family Furlough"
Contest**

Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

BY ENTERING THE CONTEST, EACH ENTRANT AGREES TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES.

1. **Eligibility:** The WUBE / Premier Shooting & Training Center "Florida Family Furlough" Online Contest (the "Contest") is open only to active duty military members or members of their immediate families who are 18 years or older and residents of Indiana, Ohio or Kentucky. Employees of Hubbard Radio Cincinnati, LLC and its station WUBE, 2060 Reading Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202 (the "Sponsor"), and Hubbard Radio, LLC, (collectively with Sponsor, the "Released Parties"), Premier Shooting & Training Center (collectively with Sponsor, the "Released Parties"), any radio, television or other media companies located in the Cincinnati area, or any of their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising agencies, or any other company or individual involved with the design, production execution or distribution of the Contest and their immediate family (spouse, parents and step-parents, siblings and step-siblings, and children and step-children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible to enter or win. Previous winners of contests conducted by the Station must comply with the following time limit before attempting to enter the Contest: Contestants may only win one prize per person at or above \$10,000 every six months unless specified otherwise. Each time limit is measured from the date the winner won their prize in the prior contest. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and Sponsor's decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.
2. **Contest Period:** The Contest begins at 6:00:00 AM Eastern Time ("ET") on April 2, 2018 and ends at 11:59:59 PM ET on April 22, 2018 (the "Contest Period").
3. **How to Enter:** You may see the Contest, including the Prize and Contest Period either by visiting www.B105.com or www.PremierShootingandTrainingCenter.com (collectively, the "Website") and clicking on the "Florida Family Furlough" banner. To enter, you must fill out the online registration form in its entirety including nominating your active military member and family to take the trip. Limit one (1) entry per person/account via this method of entry per Contest. All entries must be received by 11:59:59 p.m. ET on April 22, 2018 to be entered into the Selection Process. The nomination ranked first will be deemed the winner. If that nomination is found invalid or cannot fulfill trip obligations, the nomination ranked second becomes winner. This continues until a winner is valid and able to fulfill travel obligations.

Limit one entry per person. The entrant may be required to provide evidence that the nominated service member is valid and complete an affidavit and/or any applicable releases. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible or misdirected entries, which may be disqualified. Any attempt by any participant to enter by using multiple/different identities, or any other methods may disqualify that participant from winning any prize, at the sole discretion of Sponsor.

4. **Selection Process:** Submit your entry as outlined in Paragraph 3 above
 - a. **Semi-Finalists:** From all eligible entries received, the ten (10) top scoring entrants will be chosen by a panel of judges consisting of WUBE staff members, in their sole and absolute discretion, using the following criteria: why you say the active military family deserves to win (51%) and quality of entry (49%).
 - b. **Finalist/How the Winner Is Chosen:** the ten (10) top scoring semi-finalists will be ranked by a panel of independent judges selected by Premier Shooting & Training Center, in their sole and absolute discretion, using the following criteria: why you say your active military family deserves

to win (51%) and quality of entry (49%). The nomination ranked first will be deemed the winner. If that nomination is found invalid or cannot fulfill trip obligations, the nomination ranked second becomes winner. This continues until a winner is valid and able to fulfill travel obligations.

- c. The winner will be notified by Sponsor via email or telephone on or about the day of the selection. Failure to respond to the winner notification within **seven (7) days** will be deemed forfeiture of the Prize and an alternate winner will be selected as per the procedure specified above. Sponsor is not responsible for email or direct message notifications that are undeliverable or not received, or voicemail messages not received.
 - d. Decisions of the judges will be final and binding.
5. **Prize and Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") - One (1) Grand Prize** - A trip for up to six (6) to Marco Island, Florida July 1/1 - July 8, 2018 ONLY. Trip includes: use of Florida Beach Front Condominium maximum occupancy six (6); use of property's pool, bocce ball courts, tennis courts, shuffle board courts and workout room; unit rental, tax and cleaning fees; and six (6) \$500 VISA gift cards to be used towards travel expenses. Smoking and/or pets are not allowed on the property and are strictly prohibited. ARV: \$5,000.00.

The winner is responsible for any other costs and expenses not specified herein as being awarded. The winner is solely responsible for local, state and federal taxes on the prize. The winner and his/her guest(s) acknowledge and agree that if any alcohol is consumed by the winner and his/her guest, such alcohol consumption is at the sole discretion of the winner and his/her guest and the sponsors are not responsible for any cost or circumstances resulting from such alcohol purchases/consumption. No responsibility is assumed by the Sponsor if any part of the prize is delayed, rescheduled, postponed or cancelled in whole or in part for any reason whatsoever, including, without limitation, any force majeure event such as hurricane, fire, flood, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, war, insurrection or terrorist threat. In the event of such cancellation, the Sponsor shall have no further liability or obligation to the winner. Prize consists of only those items specifically listed as part of the prize. No cash or other substitution allowed by winner, but Sponsor may substitute the prize, or any portion thereof, for a prize of equal or greater value at Sponsor's sole discretion for any reason. All local, state, and federal taxes on the Prize are winner's sole responsibility. Taxes and fees are subject to change upon notice from Sponsor. Prize is nontransferable and not redeemable for cash.

Grand Prize winner and guest will be required to sign a liability and/or publicity release ("Prize Release") prior to issuance of a prize. A 1099 form will be submitted to all appropriate taxing authorities, and by signing a Prize Release, the Grand Prize winner accepts the Grand Prize, and even if the Grand Prize winner does not use the Grand Prize, he/she will be responsible for the applicable taxes. The Grand Prize winner must meet the eligibility requirements as set forth in Paragraph 1 of these Official Rules.

6. **Claiming the Prize:** Upon winner verification, **as a condition of being named an official winner**, each potential winner must claim his/her prize in person at WUBE Studios located at 2060 Reading Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202, during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.) within **ten (10) business days** of the day he or she confirms the receipt of notification of winning to verify that he/she is the qualified winner and may be required to sign a Publicity and Liability Release ("Release") upon (and as a condition of) picking up the Prize. Failure to comply with this deadline shall be deemed to be the winner's forfeiture of his or her right to claim the Prize. The winner must prove he or she is a qualified winner by presenting acceptable identification (e.g., military identification, state driver's license; state issued identification card; valid passport with address verification; or birth certificate with social security card and photo identification and address verification). If a winner cannot prove he or she is a qualified winner, the prize will not be awarded and the Prize will then be awarded to the next qualified entrant as specified in the process above. All unclaimed prizes remain the property of Premier Shooting & Training Center.

7. **Participation Conditions/Release/Consent to use Likeness:** By participating, each participant agrees to: (a) comply with and be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor which are binding and final in all matters relating to this Contest; (b) release and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, expenses, and liability, including, but not limited to, negligence and damages of any kind to persons and property, including, but not limited to, invasion of privacy (under appropriation, intrusion, public disclosure of private facts, false light in the public eye or other legal theory), defamation, slander, libel, violation of right of publicity, infringement of trademark, copyright or other intellectual property rights, property damage, or death or personal injury arising out of or relating to a participant's participation in this Contest, and acceptance or use or misuse of prize; (c) indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, expenses, and liabilities (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising out of or relating to an entrant's participation in the Contest and/or entrant's acceptance, use or misuse of prize; and (d) allow Sponsor's use for promotional purposes of his/her likeness, voice and/or address (city/state) without any additional compensation.
8. **General Conditions:** Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Contest, or any part of it, for any reason whatsoever, including, without limitation, fire, flood, natural or man-made epidemic of health or other means, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, satellite or equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war (declared or undeclared) or any federal state or local government law, order, or regulation, public health crisis, order of any court or jurisdiction or if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond Sponsor's reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Contest, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the participation process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Only the type and quantity of prizes described in these Official Rules will be awarded. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these rules shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.
9. **Limitations of Liability:** The Released Parties as set forth above are not responsible for: (1) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by entrants, printing errors or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest; (2) technical failures of any kind, including, but not limited, to malfunctions, interruptions or disconnections in phone lines or network hardware or software; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the participation process or the Contest; (4) technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest or the processing of phone calls; or (5) any injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Contest or receipt or use or misuse of any Prize.

By entering this Contest, each entrant agrees that the Sponsor has the right to contact the entrant by phone, direct message, or email accounts provided on the entry form to administer and fulfill this Contest.
11. **Disputes/Governing Law:** Except where prohibited, entrant agrees that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Contest or the prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate federal or state court of Ohio; (2) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual

out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Contest, but in no event attorneys' or legal fees; and (3) unless otherwise prohibited, under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, indirect, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the entrant and Sponsor in connection with this Contest shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Ohio, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of State of Ohio, or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Ohio.
